- What is the difference in how counties verify ID when voting by mail and in person?
- Which security measure during an election makes you feel most secure about voting? Why?
- Why do you think it is important for members of different political parties to be present when testing voting equipment?
- Have you or would you watch the live video feed of ballots in a secure tabulation room? Why or why not?
- What are some ways counties ensure the physical security of ballots post-election?
- How can mis and disinformation threaten election security? What steps can you take to be aware of mis and disinformation?
- Are tabulation machines connected to the internet?
